





CMMC Defined

The Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC) is a new requirement for DoD contractors, replacing the self-attestation model and moving to third-party certification.

FCI VS. CUI

FCI

Information provided by or generated from government under contracts not intended for public release.

CUI

Information the government creates or possesses, or that any entity creates or possesses for or on behalf of the government, that a law, regulation, or government-wide policy requires or permits an agency to handle using safeguarding or dissemination controls.

Public

Public information or information marked for public release

PROTECTING FCI AND CUI

CMMC Practices







COST OF BECOMING COMPLIANT



It depends:

- Maurity level being sought
- Consulting costs
- Annual or re-certification fees

COSTS OF NOT BEING COMPLIANT

Risk factors:

- Loss of CMMC-AB accrediation
- Criminal and civil litigation
- Fines and penalties
- Termination of contracts
- Restricted from future bids
- Federal funding lost
- Government hearings
- Reputational risk
- Shut out of future government contracting
